Developments at the hotel. Robert and Nick met with the owners and managers at The Bear in November to discuss the building programme and how this may impact on the club. The owners made it clear that they valued the croquet club and that for as long as they were owners, the club had nothing to fear. The builders would be instructed to protect and keep off the lawn at all times.

The first phase of the development is planned to take place through the winter of 2008/9 and involve building a brasserie on the site of the current barbecue area. The building would have come to within one metre of the current lawn so Nick is rotating clockwise the lawn's orientation slightly. This would increase the distance between the building and the lawn and also move the 'East' boundary away from the pavilion

which would improve the playing surface there.

The second phase of building will be to develop the rough area beyond the car park into new hotel accommodation but our fear of increased pedestrian traffic across the lawn is unfounded because hotel guests will be routed another way.
